

Different Ways of Giving...

The LORD said to Moses... 'You are to receive the offering for me from everyone whose heart prompts them to give.'

Electronic Bank Transfer*If you can Gift Aid the money it's worth an extra 25% to the church.*

Exodus 25:1-2

Bank Standing Order*This can also be Gift Aided. This is a good way to give regularly from a steady income.*

Cash*Gifts in notes or coins less than £20 qualify for Gift Aid, regardless of whether you're a tax payer or not.*

Pledges.....*Can you pledge money now to give at a later date? If so, please complete the appropriate form.*

Interest-Free Loan*We would be grateful to receive interest-free loans, as these reduce the interest payments on any commercial loans the church has taken out.*

Additionally, you may want to consider...

Trimming down other expenses to account for your gift to the church
Buy second-hand rather than new, eat in rather than dining out

Offering your services to the church to save other costs
Provide services like decorating, leaflet distribution or day-to-day repairs

Organising a fundraising event
Hold a bake sale, musical evening, garage sale, etc.

Making a legacy gift to the church in your will
Although not immediate, legacy gifts secure your future contribution

Giving a gift in memory of a loved one
Commemorate a family member or friend by leaving a gift to the church in their honour
